NARRATIVE

1 On 11-11-10 at approximately 0711 hours, Deputy Mefford responded to [redacted] Deland, in reference to a suicidal person. Delk, Kim (V1) contacted the Sheriff's office after her husband Delk, Ricky (S1) armed himself with a 9mm handgun and threatened to shoot himself. Before arriving onscene Delk (V1) advised Central Communications that Delk (S1) fired a single shot.

5 Upon arrival Deputies took up a tactical position around the residence and began making announcements to the occupants of the residence (Delk (V1) and Delk S1).

8 After a few minutes Delk (V1) ran out of the residence visibly scared and frantic wearing her pajamas and holding a backpack.

10 Deputies continued making announcements until Delk (S1) exited the residence at approximately 0733 hours. Delk (S1) exited the residence

13 Deputy Mefford contacted Delk (V1) who then turned over Delk (S1)'s .40 cal Glock service weapon. Delk (V1) then advised the following. Delk (V1) advised Delk (S1) was recently placed on Abilify under doctor's order's for his mental health. Delk's (S1) prescription was reportedly changed to Wellbutrin due to the side affects he was having from the Abilify. Delk (V1) stated she believed Delk (S1) began taking the Wellbutrin on Saturday 11-06-10. Delk (V1) advised during the early morning hours of 11-11-10 Delk (S1) woke her up after having a nightmare about killing himself. Delk (V1) stated she was able to calm Delk (S1) and he went back to sleep. Delk (V1) stated she was awakened a second time when Delk (S1) stated he was experiencing anxiety from having another nightmare. Delk (V1) stated Delk (S1) started asking her if she still loved him and still wanted to be with him. Delk (V1) advised they have been having marital problems and she told him that she was not in love with him anymore. Delk (V1) advised the conversation lasted approximately 15-20 minutes. Delk (V1) stated Delk (S1) told her that he could not live without her. And if she did die he would kill himself leaving their daughter with no parents. Delk (V1) stated Delk (S1) quit talking and grabbed the Glock 17 that was underneath her pillow. Delk (V1) stated Delk (S1) put the firearm to his head and said he was going to kill himself. Delk (V1) stated she went into the living room to call [REDACTED]. Delk (V1) stated Delk (S1) entered the living room and when he found out she was calling [REDACTED] he went back into the bedroom with the firearm, which he held to his head. Delk (V1) stated Delk (S1) entered the bedroom closet and fired one shot at an upward angle toward the ceiling. Delk (V1) stated she was directly outside the bedroom watching Delk (S1) as he fired the weapon. Delk (V1) stated she tried gathering up other firearms in the residence and before she knew Delk (S1) was armed with the 9mm Glock and his .40 cal Glock duty weapon. Delk (V1) stated she kept pleading with Delk (S1) to put the guns down, but he refused. At one point Delk (V1) stated she was able to tackle Delk (S1) and take the .40 cal Glock from him. Delk (V1) was able to clear the firearm and place it in the hallway out of Delk's (S1) reach. By that time Delk (V1) stated she could hear the announcements being made outside the residence. Delk (V1) advised Delk (S1) then told her he was going to commit suicide by a cop and threatened to shoot anyone who approached the residence. Delk (V1) stated she and Delk (S1) are familiar with several police officers and deputies in the area. Delk (V1) stated she then loaded the .40 cal Glock and told Delk (S1) that he was not going to shoot any police officers because they are our friends. Delk (V1) stated she never pointed the firearm at Delk (S1), but she made him aware that if he started shooting at the police then she would take action as a police officer and shoot him. Delk (V1) stated at that time she put her personal firearm .32 cal Kel Tec and Delk's (S1) service .40 cal Glock into a backpack and exited the residence. Delk (V1) advised as she was running from the residence she heard what sounded like two more gun shots.

37 Deputies cleared the residence and Deputy Mefford observed a hole in the closet wall directly above the door. The hole appeared to be made by an object traveling at an upward angle. Delk (V1) later advised that it was the location where Delk (S1) fired the shot.

38

39 Deputies obtained a consent to search the residence from Delk (V1). The Glock 9mm was later located, by Sgt Moss, inside of a unlocked plastic protein container that was used to store loose change in the bedroom where the shot was fired. The Glock 9mm was taken as evidence.

41 Photographs were also taken of the scene for evidence. Deputies were unable to locate the spent shell casing or any other bullet holes in the residence.

45 Delk (S1) was taken into custody under the Baker Act. Based on Delk's (S1) actions Deputy Mefford determined that without proper care or treatment he would be a danger to himself and or others. He was transported to ACT Pine Grove without incident.

48 Delk's (S1) personal firearms were removed from the residence and held for safekeeping.

49

50 Sgt Moss and other officers with the Daytona Beach Police Dept arrived onscene. Deputy Mefford turned over Delk's (S1) service weapon to Sgt Moss (O1).

53 It was learned during the investigation that Delk (S1) became jealous when Delk (V1) was receiving help with Math homework from a co-worker (Medrano, Iran (O2). Deputy Mefford contacted Medrano and advised him of the recent incident. Medrano advised that he understood and would contact law enforcement if Delk (S1) tried to contact him.

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57 Based on Delk's (S1) actions that were portrayed in Delk's (V1) statement, Deputy Mefford believes there is substantial evidence that Delk (S1) did shoot a firearm within an occupied dwelling. Delk's (S1) action could have killed or caused Delk (V1) serious injury due to the fact that she was standing directly outside the bedroom he fired the shot in.

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

16 advised the DEF was recently placed on Abilify under doctor's order's for his mental health. The DEF's prescription was reportedly changed to  
 17 Wellbutrin due to the side affects he was having from the Abilify. The Victim stated she believed the DEF began taking the Wellbutrin on Saturday  
 18 11-06-10. The victim advised during the early morning hours of 11-11-10 the DEF woke her up after having a nightmare about killing himself. The  
 19 victim stated she was able to calm the DEF and he went back to sleep. The victim stated she was awakened a second time when the DEF stated he  
 20 was experiencing anxiety from having another nightmare. The victim stated the DEF started asking her if she still loved him and still wanted to be with  
 21 him. The victim advised they have been having marital problems and she told him that she was not in love with him anymore. The victim advised the  
 22 conversation lasted approximately 15-20 minutes. The victim stated the DEF told her that he could not live without her. And if she did die he would kill  
 23 himself leaving their daughter with no parents. The victim stated the DEF quit talking and grabbed the Glock 17 that was underneath her pillow. The  
 24 victim stated the DEF put the firearm to his head and said he was going to kill himself. The victim stated she went into the living room to call [REDACTED]. The  
 25 victim stated the DEF entered the living room and when he found out she was calling [REDACTED] he went back into the bedroom with the firearm which he,  
 26 held to his head. The victim stated the DEF entered the bedroom closet and fired one shot at an upward angle toward the ceiling. The victim stated  
 27 she was directly outside the bedroom watching the DEF as he fired the weapon. The victim stated she tried gathering up other firearms in the  
 28 residence and before she knew the DEF was armed with the 9mm Glock and his .40 cal Glock duty weapon. The victim stated she kept pleading with  
 29 the DEF to put the guns down, but he refused. At one point the victim stated she was able to tackle the DEF and take the .40 cal Glock from him. The  
 30 victim was able to clear the firearm and place it in the hallway out of the DEF's reach. By that time the victim stated she could hear the  
 31 announcements being made outside the residence. The victim advised the DEF then told her he was going to commit suicide by a cop and  
 32 threatened to shoot anyone who approached the residence. The victim stated she and the DEF are familiar with several police officer and deputies in  
 33 the area. The victim stated she then loaded the .40 cal Glock and told the DEF that he was not going to shoot any police officers because they are  
 34 our friends. The victim stated she never pointed the firearm at the DEF, but she made him aware that if he started shooting at the police then she  
 35 would take action as a police officer and shoot him. The victim stated at that time she put her personal firearm .32 cal Kel Tec and the DEF's service  
 36 .40 cal Glock into a backpack and exited the residence. The victim advised as she was running from the residence she heard what sounded like two  
 37 more gun shots.  
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 40 object traveling at an upward angle. The victim later advised that it was the location where the DEF fired the shot.  
 41  
 42 Deputies obtained a consent to search the residence from the victim. The Glock 9mm was later located inside of a unlocked plastic protein container  
 43 that was used to store loose change. The Glock 9mm was taken as evidence. Photographs were also taken of the scene for evidence. Deputies were  
 44 unable to locate the spent shell casing or any other bullet holes in the residence.  
 45  
 46 The DEF was transported to ACT Pine Grove under the Baker Act.  
 47  
 48 The DEF's personal firearms were removed from the residence and held for safekeeping.  
 49  
 50 Based on the DEF's actions that were portrayed in the victim's statement, Deputy Mefford believes there is substantial evidence that the DEF did  
 51 shoot a firearm within an occupied dwelling. The DEF's action could have killed or caused the victim serious injury due to the fact that she was  
 52 standing directly outside the bedroom he fired the shot in.



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1 On November 11, 2010 at approximately 0711 hours, Deputy Held responded to [REDACTED] Deland, in reference to a suicidal  
 2 person. Prior to arrival, central dispatch advised the subject, later identified as Delk, Ricky (S1), was armed with a 9mm caliber handgun and  
 3 threatened to shoot himself. At approximately 0716 hours, central dispatch advised one round had been discharged, but conversation could still  
 4 be heard within the residence. Upon arrival, Deputy Held took a tactical perimeter position on the eastern side of the residence. Sgt. J. Hancock  
 5 of the Deland Police Department, initiated PA announcements from a marked patrol vehicle near the residence. A short duration later, Delk (V1)  
 6 was observed running from the front door of the residence towards law enforcement. Delk (V1) was carrying some type of bag and was wearing  
 7 pajamas with no shoes. Prior to reaching law enforcement, two loud bangs (common with discharging a firearm) were heard from within the  
 8 residence. Delk (V1) was contacted and assisted by law enforcement to a safe location nearby. Sgt. J. Hancock began PA announcements a  
 9 second time, advising Delk (S1) to exit the residence. After several minutes, Delk (S1) was observed exiting the residence (front door) with his  
 10 hands raised above his head. Delk (S1) complied with verbal commands given and was secured in the roadway.

11  
 12 Deputy Held made contact with Delk (V1), who advised there were multiple firearms and ammunition within the residence. Deputy Held  
 13 provided Delk (V1) with a voluntary consent to search (residence) form, which she completed. Post completion, Deputy Held was able to recover  
 14 multiple firearms and ammunition from within the residence (see property sheet). The Glock 17 was placed into evidence, whereas all other  
 15 firearms and ammunition were placed into evidence for safekeeping. Deputy Held took several photographs of the scene and placed said  
 16 photographs onto a CD. Subsequently, the CD was placed into the evidence locker at District 2. No further action was taken by Deputy Held.
