



**COVID-19 Situation Update 8/31/21**

**Cumulative Roanoke City and Alleghany Health Districts: 27434** (up 715 in the past week)

Alleghany Health District: **17668** total

Roanoke City Health District: **9766** total

People hospitalized with COVID-19, as of Monday 8/30/21: 48

- 35 new hospitalizations
- 22 in the Roanoke City Health District, 26 in the Alleghany Health District
- Median age: 61 years (age range <18->100)
- As a reminder, these numbers reflect hospitalizations for residents of the RCAHD. An additional 34 individuals from outside of these districts are currently hospitalized in local hospitals.

COVID-19 related deaths, as of Tuesday 8/30/21: 520
