

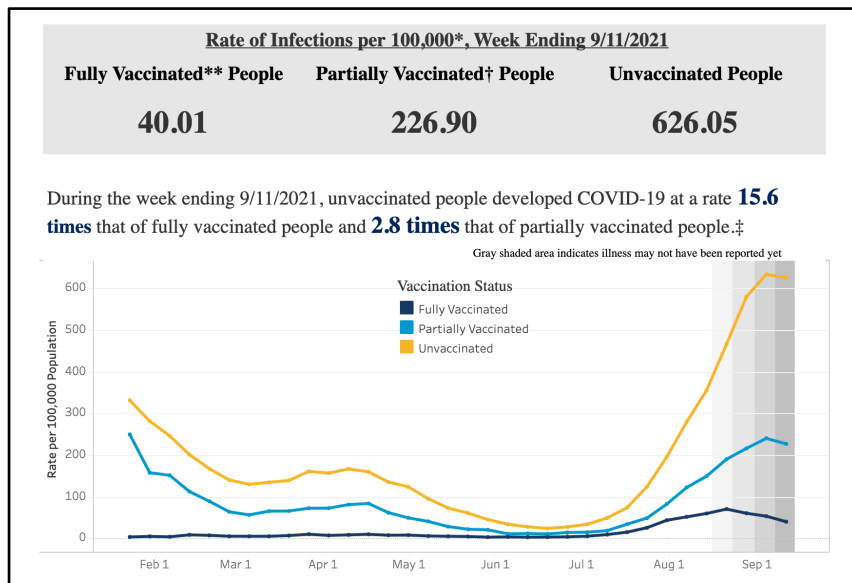
COVID-19 Situation Update 9/21/2021

Cumulative Roanoke City and Alleghany Health Districts: 30291 (up 1172 in the past week)

Alleghany Health District: **19526** total

Roanoke City Health District: **10765** total

- Approximately 20% of newly reported cases are in children
- Approximately 45% of newly reported cases are in people younger than 34 years of age
- Across [Virginia](#), for the week of 9/11/2021, the rates of COVID-19 infections were more than 15X higher in people who were not vaccinated compared to people who were fully vaccinated
- The overwhelming majority of new cases and hospitalizations occurred in individuals who are not fully vaccinated



People hospitalized with COVID-19, as of Monday 9/20/21: 93 (up 23 in the past week)

- 62 new hospitalizations
- 31 in the Roanoke City Health District, 55 in the Alleghany Health District
- As a reminder, these numbers reflect hospitalizations for residents of the RCAHD. An additional 52 individuals from outside of these districts are currently hospitalized in local hospitals.

COVID-19 related deaths, as of Tuesday 9/21/21: 538

- 327 Alleghany Health District, 211 Roanoke City Health District

Vaccine Distribution:

Including all vaccinators, over 286,000 [doses of vaccine](#) had been administered to residents of Roanoke City and Alleghany Health Districts by 9/20/2021, including over 2500 in the six days.
